Established in 1993, the Canadian Junior Golf Association had a specific goal in mind - to give junior golfers in Canada an opportunity to develop their competitive skills. Through the hard work and dedication of a few people, the Canadian Junior Golf Association has developed a program that has assisted thousands of Canadian young people. The programs offered by the CJGA are geared towards boys and girls of all ages and are designed to improve skills as well as promote competition and sportsmanship.

The CJGA is an association partner of the RCGA and has developed partnerships with a number of PGA Professionals and Canadian PGA Zones.

The Canadian Junior Golf Association conducts two tours under its umbrella – the CJGA Junior Linkster Tour and the CJGA Junior Golf Tour. The CJGA Junior Linkster Tour is for boys and girls 5-12 years of age while the CJGA Junior Golf Tour is for boys and girls, ages 12 – 19.
